

ADVERTISEMENT TO RECRUIT ENUMERATORS

The Botswana University of Agriculture and Natural Resources (BUAN) is looking to recruit four (4) enumerators who will assist in the administration of questionnaires for the project entitled “*Livelihood diversifying potential of camel based food security and climate-smart sustainable development in Botswana*” in Kgalagadi South District (Tsabong, Maubelo and Maleshe).

The objective of the survey will be to assess stakeholders’ perception and attitude towards camels, the acceptability as well as the market potential and marketing prospects for camel milk and milk products and to determine consumers’ willingness to pay for camel milk and its processed milk products.

The survey will run for 6 days (17 – 22 March 2019). Each enumerator will be required to administer 40 questionnaires in total.

Requirements

1. Diploma in Agriculture, or related fields. A BSc in Agricultural Economics, Agricultural Extension, and Food Science and Technology and proven experience as a survey enumerator will be an added advantage.
2. Applicants should be from Kgalagadi District, preferably from any one of the study sites.
